### Football for Friendship Grand Final (December 9, 2020) will include the following events:

- **2020 Football for Friendship eWorld Championship Final (eF4F).** The winners of the 2020 Football for Friendship eWorld Championship will be given super-prize.
- 2020 International Football for Friendship Grand Forum. International football experts and the Global Ambassador will announce and award the winners of the International Football for Friendship Award and the champions of the Football for Friendship eWorld Championship.

Young Participants of the programme will have unique opportunities to find new friends from different countries, improve their football skills and find useful connections. They can also become world famous because the 2020 Football for Friendship eWorld Championship (eF4F) and the Football for Friendship Grand Final will be broadcast worldwide.

The winning team will also be given an amazing prize which will be announced at the awarding ceremony.

### Requirements for the Young players:

- Age requirements: 12 years old (date of birth: from November 27<sup>th</sup> 2008 to November 27<sup>th</sup> 2009)
- Participant availability during the events of the programme
- Estimated total duration of the programme from November 27<sup>th</sup> 2020 to December 10<sup>th</sup> 2020
- Participants' estimated daily activity not less than 4 hours
- Proficiency in English: not lower than Intermediate level
- Passion for football
- Willingness to support, develop and promote the Nine Values of the programme
- High-speed Internet access, connection speed not lower than 1024 kb/s
- Smartphone and/or PC with the possibility to install the software for the participation in the event. PC requirements:
  - Windows 10 or MacOS 10.15.x
  - Keyboard and mouse

# Smartphone requirements:

- iOS 12.4 and higher (iPhone 6 and higher) or Android 8 and higher
- Recommended free disk space for PC / Smartphone not less than 400 Mb

The Global Organizing Committee of the programme completely understands possible inconveniences related to the time difference for 100 countries-participants. We will do our best to make the schedule of the programme the most comfortable for everyone. However, there is a possibility that the events will take place in the early morning or late evening hours, despite that we will try to avoid it as much as possible.

We also draw your attention to the fact that according to the requirements of the legislation on the protection of the rights and interests of minors, the registration of young participants in the programme will also entail the need to register their parents or legal representatives.
